Q. Obviously that first set can you just walk us through it, like the emotions of that whole thing?

SARA ERRANI: Well, it was tough. I mean a really long set. It was tough for me to close the point. I would always try to be aggressive. But she ran really good, she ran a lot, and I was not able to close the points, so it was tough. I was a bit angry about that. But I know that the level is there and I can win even if I was 5-3 down. I mean, just try to keep pushing, keep staying there and it was good for me.

Q. When you do get angry or emotional, how do you make sure you're keeping those emotions in check in this situation?

SARA ERRANI: Well, I want to win, so of course, I'm angry, but I want to keep going. And even if I'm angry and just competing, just fight every point, just keep concentrate keeping there, and that's it.

Q. What are your impressions of []matching up with Vesnina tomorrow?

SARA ERRANI: Yeah, for the moment I think I will talk with my coach about this one. And then tomorrow another tough match, but I'm really happy to be in the semifinal.
